Under this agreement for 2019 Hermit Park State School will receive

\$345,209*

This funding will be used to:

Goal:

- ≥87% of all students achieve A-C level of achievement (LOA) in English
- ≥14% students achieve A level of achievement in English
- Increase NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B) year 5 Writing to meet National Cohort average

Baseline:

- English %C or better All Students, (2017: 85%); (2018:87%)
- English %A All Students, Sem 1/2 (2017) : 8.7% / 16.4%; Sem 1/2 (2018) : 12% / 21%
- Year 3 Writing U2B data (2017) : 50% (2018) : 55.7%
- Year 5 Writing U2B data (2017) : 7.7% (2018) : 11.7%

Monitoring:

- Number of Indigenous students and students with disabilities identified as below benchmark in Writing and Reading
- NAPLAN pre-test

Our initiatives include:

Build capability of whole staff in the writing program across learning areas through instructional coaching and targeted professional development

Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at top performers in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning

Provide targeted, needs based intervention and support to maximise one year of learning for one year of teaching

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- \$217,2019 Employing two 1.0 FTE HoC's to lead planning, curriculum, assessment and reporting to achieve targets and improve student outcomes.
- \$106,000 Allocating additional Teacher Aide time to provide targeted, needs based intervention and support.
- \$22,000 Employing Speech Pathologist in Cluster to assist with Oral Language intervention and support across the school.
