This funding will be used to focus upon INCREASED READING ACHIEVEMENT by:

- Increasing NAPLAN Year 3 Reading Percent At or Above National Minimum Standard from 93% (Average of years 2011,12,13) to 96% (Average of years 2012,13,14)
- Increasing the school NAPLAN year 3 Reading Percentile from 68 to 70% during 2014 and 2015.

Our strategy will be to

- Implement a collaborative data based tracking cycle about Reading. (Research Basis - Faces on The Data (Sharrat and Fullan) – Strategy - Case Management of Reading)
- Early Intervention of Reading- grades P and 1. Students will be identified according to achievement benchmarks and interventions based upon Learning Connections. (Research basis – A. Faces on The Data – Early Intervention. B. Learning Connections which involves further development of sensory, motor, and primary reflex inhibitions in students to promote reading development)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing Reading support teacher aides based upon reading performance with a focus upon P-2.	\$ 119636
• Employ 0.5 Curriculum Co-ordination for alignment of reading strategies/ resource alignment/ performance tracking/ and coaching.	\$ 45000
• Building capacity of instructional leaders in the school through internal and external providers.	
• Working with P and C and School Council to actively monitor progress and review goals
