**Under this agreement for 2022
Hermit Park State School will receive**

\$352,266

This funding will be used to achieve:

- Zero Prep students on PM 0/1 (*Reading diagnostic assessment*)
- Prep-Y4 88% ≥PM benchmark
- Y5 & Y6 75% ≥SoundWaves benchmark (*Spelling diagnostic assessment*)
- ≥92% Humanities and Social Sciences Level of Achievement A - C
- ≥94% Science Level of Achievement A - C

Our initiatives include:

1. Embed capability of whole staff in literacy (reading and spelling) through instructional coaching, intentional collaboration and targeted professional development (Hargreaves & Fullan, *Professional Capital*)
2. Provide targeted, needs based intervention and support to maximise one year of learning for one year of teaching, with a focus on early years and inclusion (Hattie et al)
3. Develop a whole school approach to inquiry learning (Australian Curriculum – *Critical & Creative Thinking*; Kath Murdoch *The Power of Inquiry*)

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

- \$202,266 Provide staffing and release time to support literacy coaching, planning, curriculum, assessment and reporting to achieve targets and improve student outcomes
- \$120,000 Provide additional Student Inclusion Team support for case management, targeted intervention and classroom high impact strategies working collaboratively with classroom teachers
- \$20,000 Provide staffing and release time to support inquiry coaching, planning, curriculum, assessment to improve student outcomes; engage with expert/partner school in Kath Murdoch approach to Inquiry
- \$10,000 Temporary trial of environmental sustainability role to support enactment of Inquiry learning
